SUBJECT: U-3233-09-1 USE PERMIT for live entertainment and dancing at Spider Kelly's located at 3181 Wilson Blvd (RPC #15-075-002).

DISCUSSION: This supplemental report proposes a revised Condition #1 related to the days, times, and types of live entertainment permitted. The proposed revised condition addresses the applicant's concern that by restricting "bands" to three (3) days a week and not defining the term "band," the applicant would not be permitted to have smaller, acoustical groups on other days. The revised condition, as proposed by the applicant, provides flexibility in the types of live entertainment, while restricting live bands with full amplification to Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings, at the request of Lyon Village Citizens Association. The applicant is also proposing to end live entertainment by midnight Sunday through Wednesday. All live entertainment would be required to meet the limits established in the Noise Ordinance.

Proposed revised Condition #1:

1. Live entertainment is permitted from 4 p.m. to 12 a.m., Monday through Wednesday; 4 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. Thursday and Friday; 11 a.m. to 1:30 a.m. Saturday and the eve of all Federal Holidays; and 11 a.m. to 12 a.m. Sunday with the restriction that live bands are limited to Thursday, Friday, Saturday and the eve of all Federal Holidays. For the purposes of this condition, a "live band" is defined as a group of musicians employing a drum kit, a PA system (other than the house speakers) and full amplification (i.e. non-acoustic groups). The term "live band" does not apply to deejays, emcees, smaller groups of musicians, karaoke or other types of entertainment. ~~11:00 am to 1:30 am seven (7) days week, with the restriction that bands and deejays are permitted only from 6:00 pm to 1:30 am on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings, and on the eve of all Federal Holidays.~~


