C.M. RECOMMENDATION:

Do Not Renew the use permit for a teen parenting program due to lapse of use.

ISSUES: This is a recommendation of non-renewal for a teen parenting program that has moved to another location in the County, and no issues have been identified.


DISCUSSION: A use permit for a teen parenting program run by Arlington Public Schools (APS) was approved by the County Board in February 2005, and renewed in February 2008. The program, originally located at 1439 North Quincy Street, includes academic, vocational, and parenting instruction within a family-oriented framework. In the summer of 2009, the program was relocated to the newly reopened Reed-Westover building, at 1644 McKinley Road. The program was approved by the County Board at that location as part of the use permit for the Reed-Westover project (U-3175-07-1). Therefore, staff recommends that the use permit for the teen parenting program at 1439 North Quincy Street not be renewed.
