SUBJECT: U-3162-06-3 USE PERMIT (CARRY-OVER) to install an unmanned radio telecommunications facility on the rooftop of an existing building and locate base radio equipment on the ground in a new fenced compound, both at the premises known as the Columbus Club of Arlington, located at 5115 Little Falls Road (RPC #02-024-027).

C.M. RECOMMENDATION:

Accept withdrawal of the subject use permit request.

ISSUES: None.

DISCUSSION: Cingular Wireless originally proposed placing an unmanned radio telecommunications facility within a penthouse stealth enclosure on the rooftop of an existing building, located at 5115 Little Falls Road (Columbus Club of Arlington), and locating base radio equipment on the ground in a new fenced compound. The applicant submitted an application to be heard in September 2006, at which time a two (2) month deferral to November 2006 was requested, followed by requests for an additional two (2) month deferral to January 2007, a subsequent three (3) month deferral to April 2007 and another three (3) month deferral to July 2007, due to financial considerations. The applicant is now requesting a withdrawal of its use permit request, stating that Cingular Wireless may reapply in the next fiscal year. Staff therefore recommends the County Board accept withdrawal of this application at its July 7, 2007 meeting.
