SUBJECT: Resolution Endorsing the FY 2010 Local Plan-Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) Virginia Juvenile Community Crime Control Act ("VJCCCA") Funds.

C. M. RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the attached resolution endorsing the VJCCCA FY 2010 Local Expenditure Plan for the Juvenile & Domestic Relations District Court.

ISSUES: The proposed resolution fulfills a requirement of the VJCCCA funding process. No issues have been identified.

SUMMARY: Arlington has participated in State Block Grant funding since 1976 and continues to participate in the VJCCCA funding process. As part of that process each locality receiving grant funds is required to develop and submit a local plan. The County's plan was included in the FY 2010 adopted budget. As a condition of VJCCCA, each locality also must submit an enacted resolution authorizing the locality's participation in the plan. The attached resolution fulfills that requirement.

DISCUSSION: Pursuant to the state appropriation, Arlington County will receive \$334,420 in VJCCCA funding in FY 2010. The local match requirement (\$475,383) is included in Arlington County's FY 2010 adopted budget. These grant funds will be used to support the Argus House Boys' Group Home and the Girls' Outreach Program.

FISCAL IMPACT: None. These funds and grant revenue are included in Arlington County's FY 2010 adopted budget.

RESOLUTION ENDORSING
Arlington County's Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court's
Plan of Program Services for Fiscal Year 2010

WHEREAS, the Virginia General Assembly enacted the Virginia Juvenile Community Crime Control Act to replace the Block Grant system of funding; and

WHEREAS, Arlington County has participated in implementation of the Virginia Juvenile Community Crime Control Act since FY 1995; and

WHEREAS, localities wishing to continue to receive funding for Juvenile and Domestic Relation's District Court's programs are required to develop and submit a local plan; and

WHEREAS, the Arlington County Board has developed a local plan in the adopted budget for FY 2010,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia, that the County Board will participate in implementation of the Virginia Juvenile Community Crime Control Act and accept funds appropriate for the purposes set forth in the Act until it notifies the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice, in writing, that it no longer wishes to participate, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arlington County Manager is hereby authorized to execute a local plan on behalf of the County Board of Arlington County.
