**C.M. RECOMMENDATION:**

Discontinue the subject use permit for a summer day camp.

**DISCUSSION:** In May 2004, the County Board approved this use permit for a summer day camp for children with communication disorders at Mount Vernon Baptist Church. The summer day camp was operated by the George Washington Speech and Hearing Department to provide training to graduate students who are studying to become Speech-Language Pathologists. The operator has not run a summer day camp at Mount Vernon Baptist Church for the past two (2) year and indicates no intention of providing such a program in the future. Therefore, staff recommends that the County Board discontinue the use permit for a summer day camp.
